**Abba Matta** is known in the West as Matthew the Poor, and is widely regarded as the greatest Egyptian elder since St. Antony the Great. He produced a huge and varied body of work in Arabic, only a little of which has been translated into English. In addition, a great many of his informal talks to monks and visitors were recorded. He had a marvelous ability to communicate the deepest spiritual truths in the simplest and most practical language, making them accessible to laypeople as well as monastics. 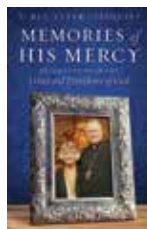

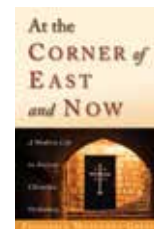

## Akathist to Jesus, Light to Those in Darkness

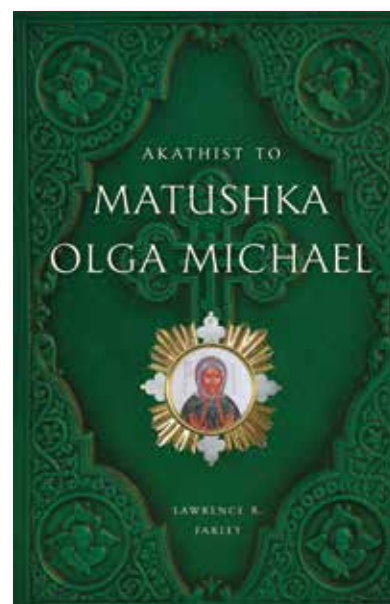
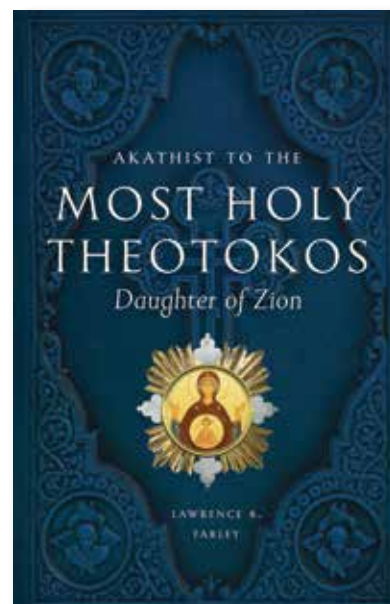
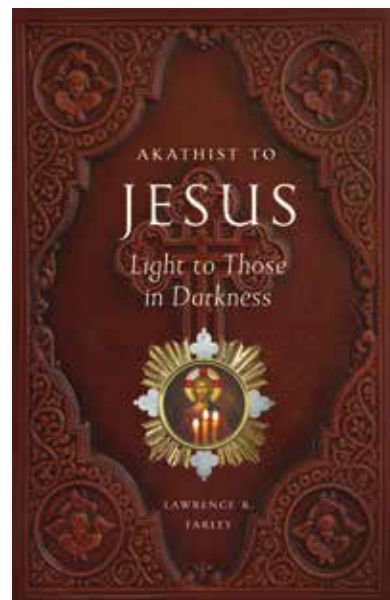
Eventually, everyone comes to dwell in darkness for a time. That is when we need to turn to Jesus, the only Light of the world and the only rescue for those in pain and despair. We break through the darkness by offering praise to God. This akathist is for all who sojourn in the darkness, with the prayer that they will use such praises as this to break through.

## Akathist to the Most Holy Theotokos, Daughter of Zion

Zion in the Old Testament is a type of the Holy Mother of God. As God chose to dwell in Zion and thus blessed and glorified her, so God also chose to dwell in Mary and to bless and glorify her. In the New Testament, Jerusalem is revealed as both a virgin and a mother—just like the Holy Theotokos. This akathist draws on scriptures that reveal this image of Mary as Zion, so that we may see anew Christ's Gospel work revealed in the Old Testament.

## Akathist to Matushka Olga Michael

Matushka Olga was the wife of a Yupik priest in an Alaskan village. She was not only mother to her own eight surviving children, but also spiritual mother to those in her parish. Olga served quietly, working as midwife in her village and constantly caring for the needy. She had a special gift in working with those who suffered abuse, especially sexual abuse. After her repose on November 8, 1979, many people experienced her coming to them in dreams, bringing her healing gifts. Matushka Olga's sanctity reveals the possibilities for genuine theosis and holiness, even for those living in the world.

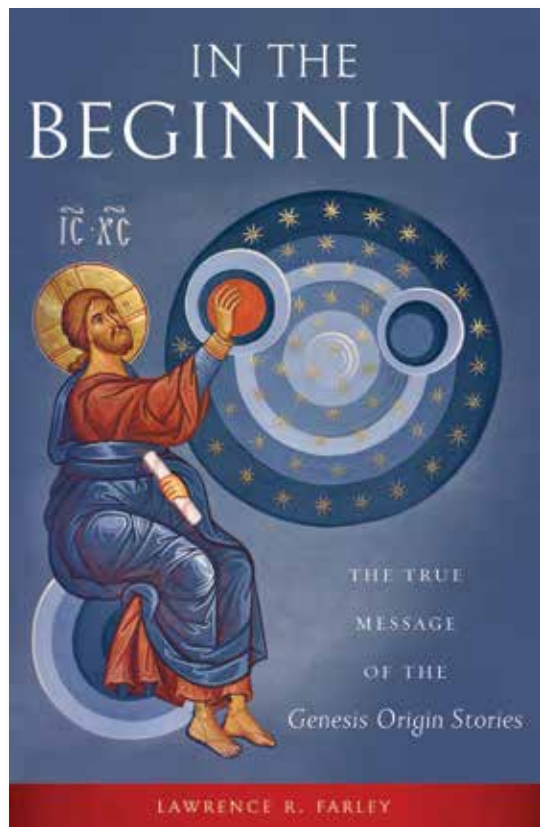

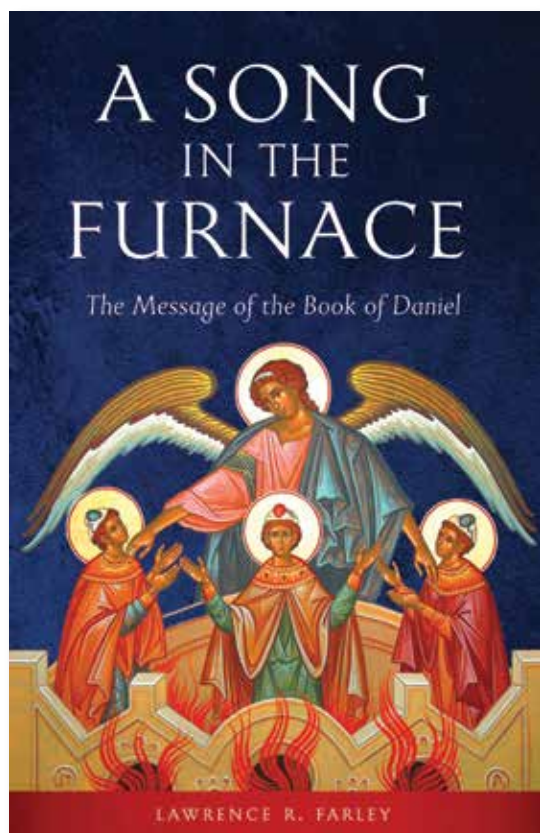

## Time and Despondency

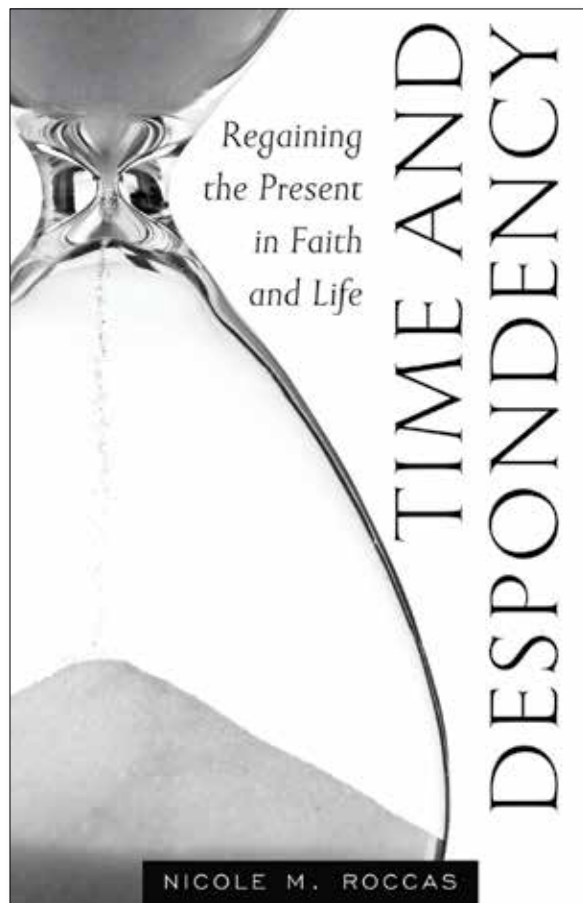
### Regaining the Present in Faith and Life

Idleness. Apathy. Restlessness. Procrastination. These are symptoms of what early Christian theologians called despondency (*acedia*), a spiritual sickness rooted in a lack of care or effort. A condition as old as the ancients, despondency thrives in today's culture of leisure, anxiety, and digital distraction. *Time and Despondency* is a penetrating synthesis of ancient theology, spiritual memoir, and self-help practicality. It envisions despondency as the extension of a broken relationship with the experience of time. Driven by the fear of death and the anxiety of living, despondency drives us to abandon the present moment, forsaking the only temporal realm in which we have true fellowship with Christ. The remedies offered by time-honored Christian thinkers for this predicament constitute not only an antidote to despondency but also stepping stones back to the present moment. In regaining the sacredness of time, we re-encounter the Resurrection of Christ in the dark and restless moments of our lives.

## Bearing God

### The Life and Work of St. Ignatius of Antioch the God-Bearer

St. Ignatius, first-century Bishop of Antioch, called the “God-bearer,” is one of the earliest witnesses to the truth of Christ and the nature of the Christian life. Tradition tells us that as a small child, Ignatius was singled out by Jesus Himself as an example of the childlike faith all Christians must possess (see Matthew 18:1–4). In *Bearing God*, Fr. Andrew Damick recounts the life of this great pastor, martyr, and saint, and interprets for the modern reader five major themes in the pastoral letters he wrote: martyrdom, salvation in Christ, the bishop, the unity of the Church, and the Eucharist.

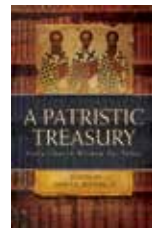

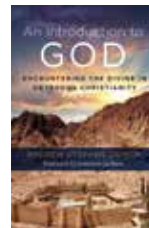

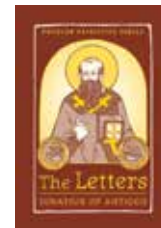

## When You Pray A Practical Guide to an Orthodox Life of Prayer

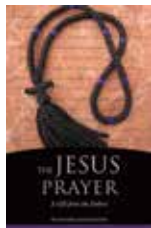
Anyone who prays, or has tried to pray and given up in discouragement, knows praying—really praying—is not easy. Praying consistently seems almost impossible. Too often and too easily, prayer becomes a burden: one more item on an already overcrowded to-do list. Failing to pray becomes a source of guilt and stress as we must once again admit our inconstancy and procrastination to our father confessor. Yet, our Lord said, “Come to me, all of you who are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. My burden is easy and my yoke is light” (Matt. 11:30). **Joined to Christ**  
Understanding an Orthodox Baptism  
BY FR. STEPHEN FREEMAN

FEW SERVICES IN THE ORTHODOX CHURCH have older elements and texts than that of Holy Baptism. If you listen carefully to the words of the prayers and watch the actions that take place, you will have experienced a small summary of our entire faith. Baptism is nothing less than our participation in the death and resurrection of Christ Himself. At the same time, it reveals how the Church understands and proclaims those most central events in history.



In many contemporary non-Orthodox groups, baptism is reserved to adults. However, the baptism of infants is a tradition the Church received from the Apostolic churches. It represents a different understanding of the very nature of the Christian life. It makes society, grace baptism is placed on children and infants. We realize that our children are the primary forces that shape our tomorrow. We do not only become consumers of religion.

The service begins with a direct confrontation with the powers of evil. The candidate (or parent and sponsors of an infant) is asked to renounce Satan and all the forces of evil. These renunciations are made three times and continue to usually opening to the Lord. The dramatic action is immediately followed by an act of union: "Do you come peacefully with Christ?"

The candidate has chosen sides in the conflict that defines the very essence of the universe. In Christ, God has acted decisively to defeat sin and death and emptying that death becomes sin and our communion with Him. This is truly a life-and-death decision.

Sacraments in the Orthodox Church are understood to do exactly what they say—they are not symbols of something else or metaphors on abstracted ideas. In Holy Baptism, the candidate is truly united with the very death and resurrection of Christ. St. Paul says, "Do you not know that as many of us were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death?" (Rom. 6:3).


The actions of the service offer a graphic depiction of our victory in Christ. The floating into the waters recalls the waters of creation in Genesis, connecting them as well with the waters of the Jordan River, in which Christ Himself was baptized. In Orthodox understanding, those waters also represent the gates of Hades. Christ descended into the waters just as He would descend into Hades after His death on the Cross. In Hades He "did not give up" (Eph. 4:8) and "having defeated the powers and authorities, He made a public spectacle of them, trampling over them by the cross" (Col. 2:15 NIV).

The candidate is given a candle that reminds us of Christ as the Light of the world. When everything is made ready, the candidate is immersed three times in the water, in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. The ancient tradition of the Church is to immerse rather than to sprinkle as

**The Two Shall Become One Flesh**  
Understanding an Orthodox Wedding  
BY FR. STEPHEN FREEMAN

WEDDINGS ARE AMONG THE MOST TRADITIONAL ACTIVITIES in American religious culture. Images of bridal processions, music, and vows exchanged all form part of the popular imagination. An Orthodox wedding will therefore seem very different for the non-Orthodox. The couple does not design their own service. No vows are exchanged. Crowns are placed on the heads of the bride and groom. A cup of wine is shared. The imagery is greatly different.

FOR THE ORTHODOX, marriage is a sacrament, a holy mystery in which God enters a man and a woman so that they together become "one flesh." They are not simply agreeing to live together or to work together for a common cause. This relationship is a sacrament because two individuals, in a real sense, are joined together to become one life—a new reality of existing in the world. Each spouse will find the truth of his or her life in the life of the other.

places at the beginning of the wedding.

The priest announces, "The servant of God, N., is betrothed to the handmaid of God, N., in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." This is declared three times (signifying the perfection of the Holy Trinity) over both the man and the woman. The rings are placed on their right hands and are then exchanged three times. A solemn prayer follows.

In an ancient series of prayers, the priest recalls the many married couples in Scripture and prays that this couple may be blessed in a manner similar to them. God's actions in establishing marriage and His many acts of wisdom on our behalf are also recalled. Through these prayers, the particular marriage is placed into the context of the people of God throughout the history of the world. Marriage is not a private matter but the work of God for the salvation of the world.

Then comes the crowning. The style of crowns varies greatly throughout the Orthodox world—they may be of gold, of brass, or of flowers, from simple to ornate. In every case, the crown recall the crown of the martyr to heaven. The husband and wife are crowned, showing that in their union they will by doing that love for each other the way best of love is taught by Christ (Eph. 5:17).


The Common Cup

Sacrament prayers are read, one from St. Paul's Epistle to the Ephesians, the other from St. John's Gospel, recalling Christ's first miracle at the wedding in Cana. After the readings, a common cup of wine is blessed and given to the couple.

The origins of the cup are hidden in history, but they seem to be linked to ancient customs in which the couple symbolically share a meal (a common cup is also

**With the Saints Give Rest**  
Understanding an Orthodox Funeral  
BY FR. STEPHEN FREEMAN

IT HAS BECOME COMMONPLACE in American culture to keep funerals somewhat "light." Our culture seems fearful of sad emotions and grief. Indeed, it is not unusual to hear it said that funerals are for the living, not for the deceased. An Orthodox funeral, however, consists primarily of prayers and actions offered on behalf of the departed.

It's something that has been discarded with the soul is ours as the true self. This is not the teaching of the New Testament nor the understanding of the Orthodox Church. We were created as body and soul, a "being" in the words of Genesis. Death is sign in that it represents the temporary departure of the soul from the body. The body and the soul are not seen to be apart.

We believe that God holds our souls in existence while we await the resurrection of our bodies at the day of Christ's second coming. The Scriptures speak many promises of rest to those who are with God. We believe they are aware of us and pray for us (Heb. 12:1 Rev. 7:9-10).

Having made these observations, we should add that there is much about our life with God after death that we simply do not know. The Orthodox Church practices rituals in such things rather than speculation. What we do speak are the words heard repeatedly in the funeral itself:

Again, we pray for the repose of the servant of God, departed (St. Nic), and that he/she may be pardoned all his/her sins, both voluntary and involuntary... That the Lord will establish his/her soul where the just remain... The saints of God, the Kingdom of Heaven, and the righteous of Israel, are in an end of Christ, the anointed King and God.

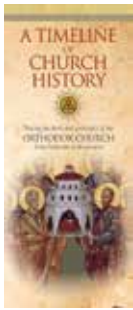
And most especially:

O God of spirits and of all flesh, who has triumphed down death by death, underventures the dead, and give life to Your world; give rest, O Lord, to the soul of Your departed servant, \_\_\_\_\_, to a place of brightness, a place of refreshment, a place of repose, where all sickness, sighing, and sorrow have had none. Prayers many intercession which he/she has committed, whether by word or deed or thought. For You are a good God and love mankind, because there is no man who lives yet does not sin. For You only are without sin. Your righteousness is to all mercy, and Your word is truth.

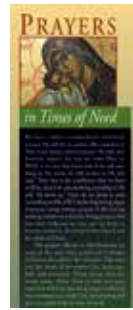
Often the custom of the service, custom prayers and hymns will be sung between the clergy and the choir, and incense will be offered along with the prayers.

When commemorations proceed, the funeral takes place on the third day after death. Additional prayers are offered on the sixth day and the fortieth day, and then on the anniversary of the death each year. These prayers are a common and vital part of Orthodox life. In fact, there is no service in the Orthodox Church where the departed are not remembered. The funeral is the beginning of a new
